### A Plea from our SHAPE, Eco and HI Councils.

We want to make planters to grow vegetables in to use in the kitchen/sell in the summer. To make the planters, we are going to use Eco-Bricks. This is a whole school project. It involves using the plastic that is non-recyclable (such as; crisp packets, fruit wrappers, plastic around tins), and filling a plastic bottle with these plastics

How to make an Eco-Brick:

- 1) Get your non-recyclable plastics ready (ensure they are clean. For instance, not if it has been around meat).
- 2) Get your plastic bottle ready - use a 1.5l/2l cola or lemonade bottle without a long neck.
- 3) Push the non-recyclable plastic into the bottle (Top tip: use a wooden spoon handle to help).
- 4) The Eco-Brick needs to weigh a third of the original weight (if the bottle was 2l, it needs to weigh about 600g). Don't worry we can check these for you!
- 5) When the Eco-Brick is ready, please label with child's name and bring into school on the collection day.

Shape, Eco and HI council are going to run and organise this project. We will collect these Eco-Bricks on a **Thursday morning**. If the Eco-Brick is not heavy enough, then we will return for you to fill some more (it can be tricky!)
