Dear Parents/carers,

Welcome to Year 4!

I hope you have all enjoyed your summer holidays and are ready for a new school year. I am looking forward to working with you and your child this year. This letter is to welcome you to Year 4 and give some information for term 1 and 2.

## School Uniform

As it is the start of a new school year, please ensure that both school uniform and PE kit are clearly labelled with your child's full name. In addition to this, we do ask that the Hutton School logo is clearly visible on your child's uniform. Unnamed items will be taken to lost property and if not claimed, shall be donated to Bags to School.

## PE

The children will be continuing with swimming lessons every Wednesday up until Christmas, by when we hope they will have all mastered their 25m. Please ensure that your child has their swimming kit in school for these lessons. Our PE this term shall be gymnastics on a Monday. All children will need to have their school PE kit in school for this day. The indoor PE kit is: a white polo shirt with the school logo, green shorts and daps. If your child is wearing tights, please ensure that they bring a pair of socks to school with them. In term 2, we shall have Chris Millard from North Somerset Athletics Academy with us for cross country - this will be on Tuesday. We will try and get outside for every lesson so please ensure that the children have an appropriate kit (tracksuit trousers and trainers).

We shall continue with a mile-a-day for this school year. Please can children have a pair of trainers and socks in school for this (this could be part of their outdoor PE kit).

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## Homework

Your child will be expected to practice their times tables and spellings and read daily at home. By the end of year 4, the children are expected to know all their times tables to 12x12 and their corresponding division facts. E.g.  $56 / 7 = 8$

Homework and reading logs will be given out on **Fridays** and they shall be collected each **Wednesday**. Please see the homework time table to see the homework that has been set for that week. Reading log activities are to be completed each week. The homework will either be an activity from the "10 things to do" list or it will be a set piece of English, Maths or PSHME.

## Reading Logs

A reading log activity needs to be completed once a week. The list of activities shall be stuck on the front page of their reading logs. The children will have completed an activity in school to show the children of the expectations when completing this activities. Children are to use pencil in their books and they have to complete it to a high standard.

## Home-school Link Books

We are continuing to use the back of the reading log books as a form of communication. This shall be checked on a **Wednesday** when they hand their books in.
