Dear Parents,

Morning start times for Year 4 and 5

Thank you for your patience whilst we make minor adjustments to the start and end of the day. There will be slight change to dropping off times for Year 5 and 4. Please could Year 5 arrive at 8:40 and Year 4 at 8:45am. Please note that the gates for Year 4 will close at **8:55**. Children arriving after this time will have to enter the school building by the office and will be marked as **late**.

Reception children will start at 8:55 and will only be marked as late if they arrive after 9am.

At the end of the day please can you collect your child from their allocated gate. Some parents are waiting at the entrance gates and signalling to the class teacher to send their child out. Unfortunately, this is only adding to the congestions at the gates. Thank you for your cooperation.

Coronavirus

The guidance from Government continues to change from day to day. However, the one clear message is that if you are suffering from any of the following to self-isolate:
a high temperature;
a new, continuous cough;
or the loss or change of sense of taste or smell

Please do not send your child to school if they are suffering from any of these symptoms but please do inform the school office.

If you or child are showing any of these symptoms please follow the Government Guidance and take a test. However, you should **only** be tested if you are showing the **three main symptoms** unless instructed otherwise by the local health authority, health protection team or your GP. If your child does feel unwell, for example with a sore throat, stomach upset or a headache you do not need to book a test. If you are unsure what to do please contact school.
