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Links for Maths

When helping your child to understand a particular number, it is about much more than recognising the numeral itself. Do lots of counting of objects, practise recognising the numeral, recognising the dice pattern without counting, looking for numbers within it (eg 6 is 5 and 1 more), talk about 'one more' and 'one less' than the number. Encourage your child to see the patterns within each number – for example, 6 objects can be arranged as 5 and 1 more, or 2 lots of 3 objects, 3 lots of 2 objects etc. Watch the relevant Numberblocks episodes with your child and discuss it with them afterwards.
