I know this current situation of closed bubbles causes difficulty for parents but we are trying to ensure we follow all the guidance given. When I spoke to Public Health yesterday, I asked specifically about this difficulty for parents. The advice was that the isolating person MUST NOT leave your house/garden. 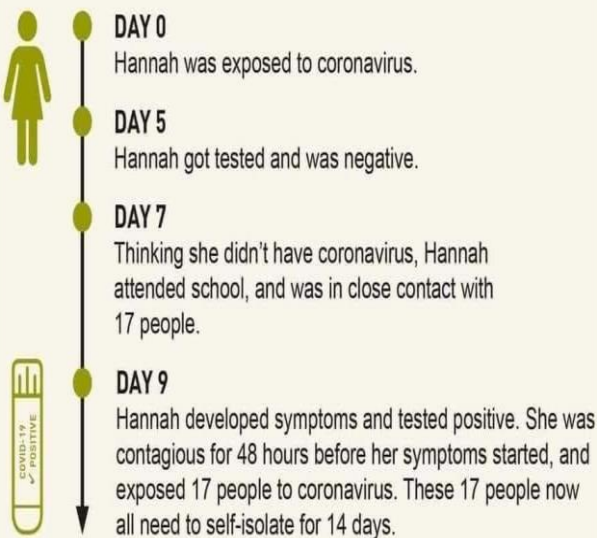
