Think about if these foods are the most important thing about Easter for many Christians. Discuss with your adult what each food symbolises. Can you draw a picture that you think symbolises the most important thing about Easter for Christians. Write an explanation, remembering to use the word 'because'.</p>	<p>RE – What does Salvation mean? Salvation means to save someone or something from being hurt. Topic	<p>Pick your Queen – What sort of Monarch would you be? We have thought about the values that Queen Elizabeth I and Queen Victoria stood for and how those values were shown in their portraits. Can you try and come up with 5 words or phrases to describe your own values if you were to become a contemporary monarch (e.g. a good friend; a good listener; a good sharer; treats everyone the same; encourages fun). Think with your adult about how you could represent these values. Remember that symbols can be quite simple in form and could be animals, flowers, objects, etc. Over the next fortnight I would like you to create a throne that you think would represent your values.
