Topic Geography: The Americas Knowledge Organiser 1 hr	Identify the countries of North and South America Is the USA the same or different to North and South America? Read through this PowerPoint , then complete the map activity – use an atlas or Google map to help you. Challenge yourself if you dare!	Describe the location and characteristics of two places in the Americas Recap on latitude and longitude and learn about climate zones in this PowerPoint . Topic Geography: The Americas Knowledge Organiser 1 hr	Compare the human and physical geography of two locations in the Americas. Definitions: Physical geography includes natural features, eg, rivers, flora, fauna, climate and weather. Human geography is related to the actions of humans, eg human habitants, types of buildings etc. Your task is to research the physical and human geography of: 1. Amazon Basin in South America 2. Denver, Colorado, North America. Use the links provided to start you off. Note down how they are similar and how they are different to each other. Final paragraph is to compare the human and physical geography of these areas to where you live.	Why was the state of Georgia, USA a good region for slavery? Think about why humans choose to live in some areas. Find the state of Georgia on a map and consider the physical geography of the area. Note – Georgia was the first region for slavery in the USA. List all the reasons you think Georgia was a good base for the slave trade using your knowledge of physical and human geography. I would like you to create some work (either written or drawn with annotations) to demonstrate how the human and physical geography made the state of Georgia a viable region to bring slaves to.
