Welcome Back

A very warm welcome back to everyone, it was lovely to see so many smiling faces this morning as the children walked through the gate. We hope that you all had a good summer and now that we have returned back to school it looks like the sun is going to make a reappearance!

School routines

As the restrictions have been lifted old school routines will resume with caution. Playtimes will see the mixing of children from two classes and lunchtimes will see the return of all children eating their lunches in the hall (albeit at staggered times as the hall does not accommodate the whole school eating at the same time.)

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Breakfast and After School club

COVID-19

If your child develops the three main symptoms of Covid please inform the school, follow the Government rules, and take them for a PCR test.

If you or your child have COVID symptoms and you are unsure what to do please contact the school office and we will advise you what to do.

Free School Meals

Have your circumstances at home changed? Your child will be entitled to free school meals if you get any of these benefits:

- Income support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance (JSA)
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA)
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on, paid for four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit with annual take home pay/net earnings below £7,400 (which equals £616.67 per month) benefits not included
