Home Learning

We are expected, by the Government, to provide a full day of education for any children who are unable to attend school because they are self-isolating due to the Coronavirus outbreak. Teachers have been working hard to produce a scheme of work that will match the curriculum being taught in class. Maths

Four days of White Rose maths videos and worksheet will be uploaded to the class page, weekly. The fifth day, Friday, children will be expected to play maths games on either Purple Mash or Top marks. Alternatively, revise, practise or complete any work from this week.

We are expecting children to practise Times Tables Rockstars or Numbots daily. The children will be sent home with their logins for these sites over the next week. Please contact the class teacher if the child has lost their logins.

English

Each class will be set a writing project via the talk4writing <https://www.talk4writing.com/home-school-units/> website. If your child needs to stay at home, they should start the project from the first activity in the booklet. Please see the class plan for more details.

Children will be expected to read and login to Spelling shed daily.

Please continue to log your child's reading on the sheet sent home at the beginning of term.

Foundation subjects – History, Geography, Science, RE

Your child will be expected to complete one of these subjects per day.

Physical Activity

The teacher will not be setting any tasks for PE however we feel it is incredibly important that all children participate in at least 30 minutes of physical activity per day. We have listed some suggested activities and websites that can be completed at home.

Workbooks

Your child will be provided with an exercise book to work in.
