<b>RE</b> 1 hr	<b>Think about the commitments we make</b>  Write down a list of 5 goals that you currently have, they may be school work related, sports related or health related (e.g completing 75 club, scoring more goals than last season, increasing your level of fitness).  Which of these goals are most important to you? Is there a reason why. Plot them using the commitment continuum, next to each commitment explain why you have placed it at that point on the continuum.	<b>Understand some Sikh sacrifices</b>  Watch the <a href="#">BBC clip</a> on the forming of the Khalsa and the sacrifices Sikhs were prepared to make for their God. Note down what the people in the story were prepared to sacrifice and why you think that is. The Khalsa was founded in 1699 by the last Guru (Gobind Singh). Members show their allegiance by five signs called the five Ks which you can read about <a href="#">here</a> . In your book write a paragraph explaining how easy you think it is to keep to the five Ks in modern day society, What might prevent you?	<b>Consider what the Langar means to Sikhs</b>  During the forming of the Khalsa some Sikhs were prepared to sacrifice their lives. Guru Nanak (the first Sikh Guru) expected Sikhs to give a lot for and to their religion. What are they prepared to give? What levels of commitment?  Watch the <a href="#">BBC clip</a> 'Sikh belief and Worship' that focuses on Langar and read the five key beliefs here. In your book write down the 5 beliefs with an explanation as to how they are shown through Langar.
