The children will sit in their Tribe groups, which will allow families sit together. Please feel free to bring picnic blankets and foldable chairs to sit on.

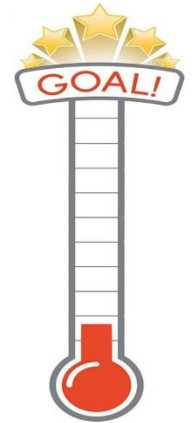
### Y5 fundraiser for Ukraine
