RE People of God 1 hour	<p>Compare Jesus' two new commandments with the Ten Commandments.</p> <p>Jesus wrote a new commandment to show a new relationship with God – Matthew 22:37-40. Jesus replied: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind". This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second (commandment) is like it: 'Love your neighbour as yourself'. All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments"</p> <p>Compare the new commandments "love the Lord..." with the Ten Commandments. How are they the same/different? What would happen if they are broken?</p>	<p>Write a persuasive advert to encourage Christian practise</p> <p>Look up Toybox https://toybox.org.uk/ – a Christian charity that supports and liberates street children in South and Central America, India and Africa.</p> <p>Your task is to write an article to go on Toybox's website to encourage Christians in the UK to support their work.
