I wanted to keep you updated on my meeting this week with North Somerset planning committee and the parish and ward councillors as well a representative from the MAT. There are plans to improve the areas around the school, to help provide safety for our children and the wider community.

As well as proposed changes to the infrastructure of the roads, there was some news around the village hall parking. The committee has decided that the school may no longer use the car park. Parents cannot park there at drop off or pick up. I have also been told that law enforcement will be out and about to check that no one is dropping off children by pulling in on yellow lines or in restricted areas, like opposite the T junction outside the school. This obviously will provide some initial concerns to our parents that live outside the village and have no option but to drive, but we are going to be working with local council to promote a culture of sustainable / healthy options for travel, where walking, biking, scootering is the norm for any local family.

From Tuesday, next week, no-one is allowed to use the carpark.

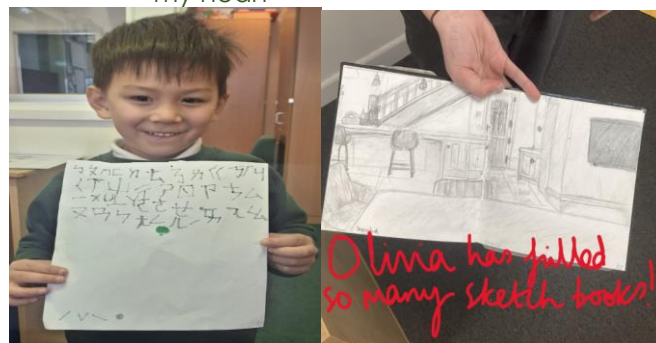
Although our hands are tied, we will aim to turn this into a positive for our children.
