



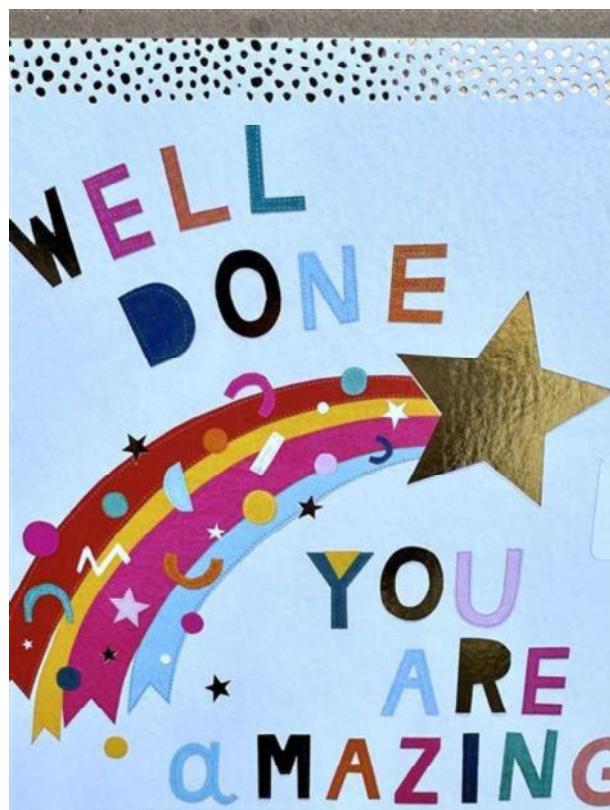

This weeks celebrations..

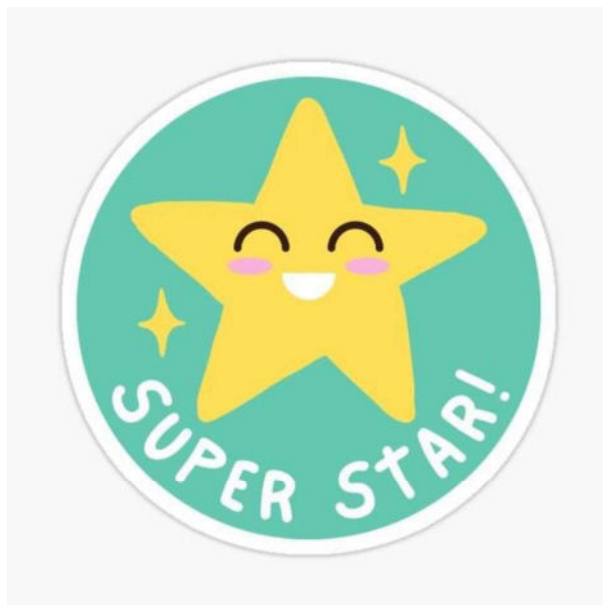
