

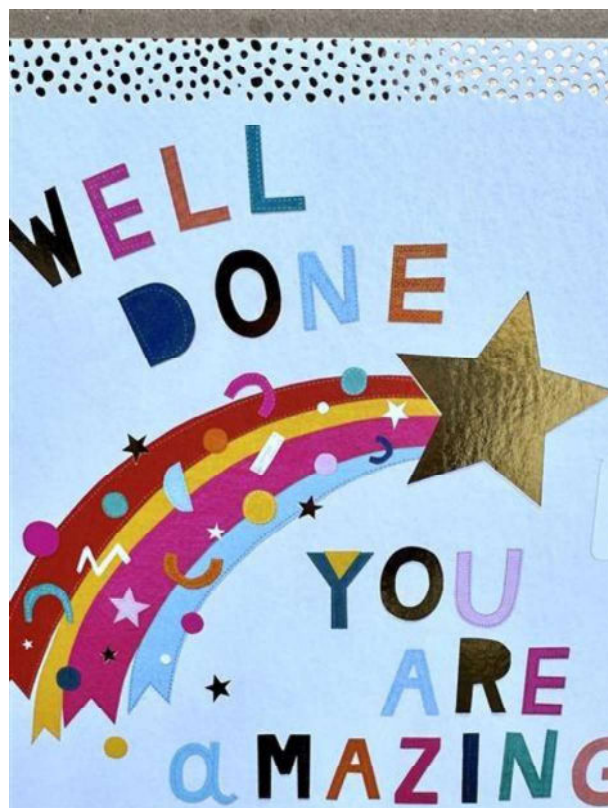

Firstly, thank you for your understanding and help with the extreme heat this week. The good news is that we are hoping to get the first two classrooms air conditioned within the next few months, which would mean a partial opening might be possible on a rota system should we experience this again.

We appointed a new teacher last week, Charlotte Taylor, to replace Miss Shallcross. More information about which teachers are teaching where will be shared next week.

We are expecting to hear from Ofsted in the next couple of weeks that they can resume their inspection - which we are hoping is before the end of term. Part of this is ensuring we capture the parents views of the school fully, not only for Ofsted but for ourselves so we can look at future areas for improvement as well as celebrating what is working well. 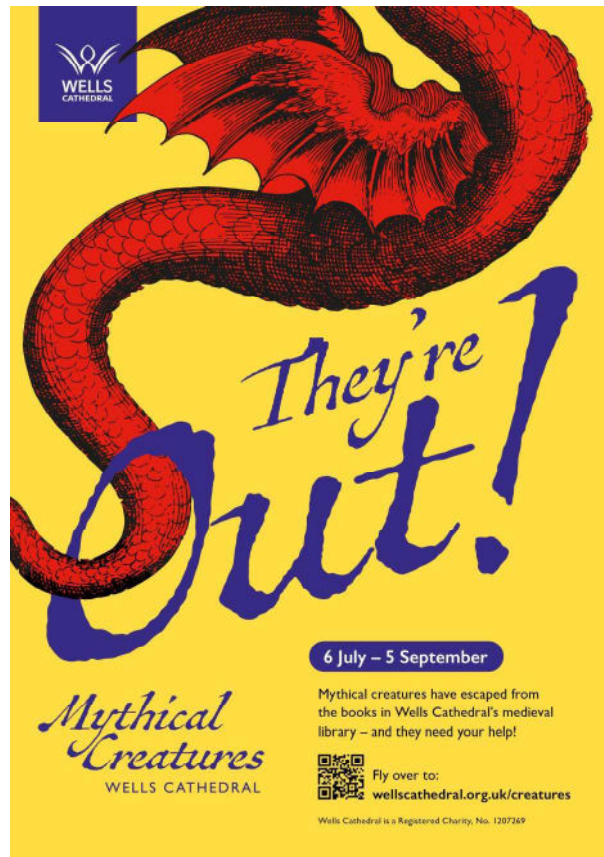
We are also busy preparing for our Summer Fair, we would be very grateful for any raffle/toy/teddy donations, thank you so much for your support - we couldn't do it without you!
